## Financial Aid Requirements

### **ALL INTERNATIONAL AND GRADUATE APPLICANTS THAT PASS PRESCREENING**

Must submit the *NEC Application for Institutional Scholarship + Financial Assistance* form via your application portal. ↗

### **DOMESTIC APPLICANTS**

Domestic applicants must also submit the *FAFSA* by February 15. ↗

## Prepare to audition

## Start your [NEC application](#)

- Begin to gather application materials like unofficial transcripts, essays, artistic resume and TOEFL/IELTS scores (if applicable).
  - Reach out to your recommenders early so that they have time to write your letters of recommendation.

## Submit your application by **December 1**

Most NEC programs require video recordings for pre-screening. If required, NEC will notify you in late December of the prescreen decisions, and let you know if you have been invited for a final audition or interview. Good luck!

## Final audition

If selected, perform your final audition/ interview in either late January or February (dates vary by major).

## Receive decision by **April 1**
